Funding acceptance agreement

By signing the following document you acknowledge and agree to the following:

- I am a current student at UBC's Okanagan campus
- The funding being offered will not be spent on any degree, curriculum, or academic requirements
- The funding being offered will not pay the wages or subsidize any income for students, and/or mentors
- The funding being offered will not be used to purchase alcohol or drugs
- In order to be reimbursed, I must provide the Tuum Est Student Initiative Fund (TESIF) Program Administrator with original itemized receipt(s) of expenses and payment receipt(s) associated with my initiative as well as a completed TESIF Reimbursement Form (available online at bit.ly/TEsIFrecipients)
- Submitted receipts of paid expenses must align with the proposed and approved budget
- If I receive reimbursement for any expenses incurred by someone other than myself, I agree to repay that person for their expenses from the reimbursement
- Expenses are subject to related UBC policies
- The Program Administrator will submit all submitted receipts to UBC Okanagan Finance Operations and Strategies. I may request a copy of receipts for my records
- All receipts must be submitted no later than one week after the initiative end date to be eligible for reimbursement

By signing the following document, I acknowledge and agree to the following indemnity clause:

- I shall indemnify and hold harmless the University and its affiliates from any claims brought against the University or its affiliates by third parties as a result of the actions or inactions of myself or my employees, agents and/or subcontractors, including any damages, legal fees, or expenses arising from such claims. However, I shall not be liable under this indemnity to the extent that such claims are the result of the negligence of the University.
