## **Purpose**

This report is intended to provide a high-level overview of the 2022 Work Study application and funding approval outcomes.

## **Funding Recommendations**

The funding approval rate of the applications has doubled since last year and the number of applications waitlisted has reduced significantly. The funding budget allows more applications to be funded, creating more opportunities for students on campus.

### **1. Full Funding: Summer and Winter applications**

Full funding is recommended for summer and winter applications scoring 19 - 24.

### **1. Partial Funding: Summer and Winter applications**

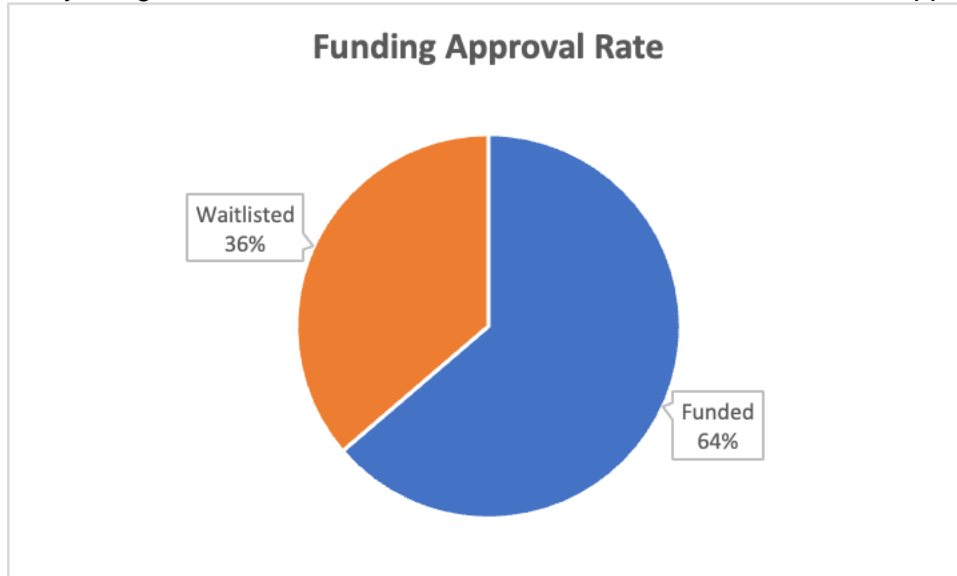
Applications scoring 18 – 18.75 are recommended to receive funding for one full position in the summer term (340 hours) and one full position in the winter term (408 hours) with any additional hours waitlisted.

### **1. Waitlist: Summer and Winter applications**

It is recommended that applications with a score below 18 be waitlisted for the summer and winter terms.

## Funding Approval Rates

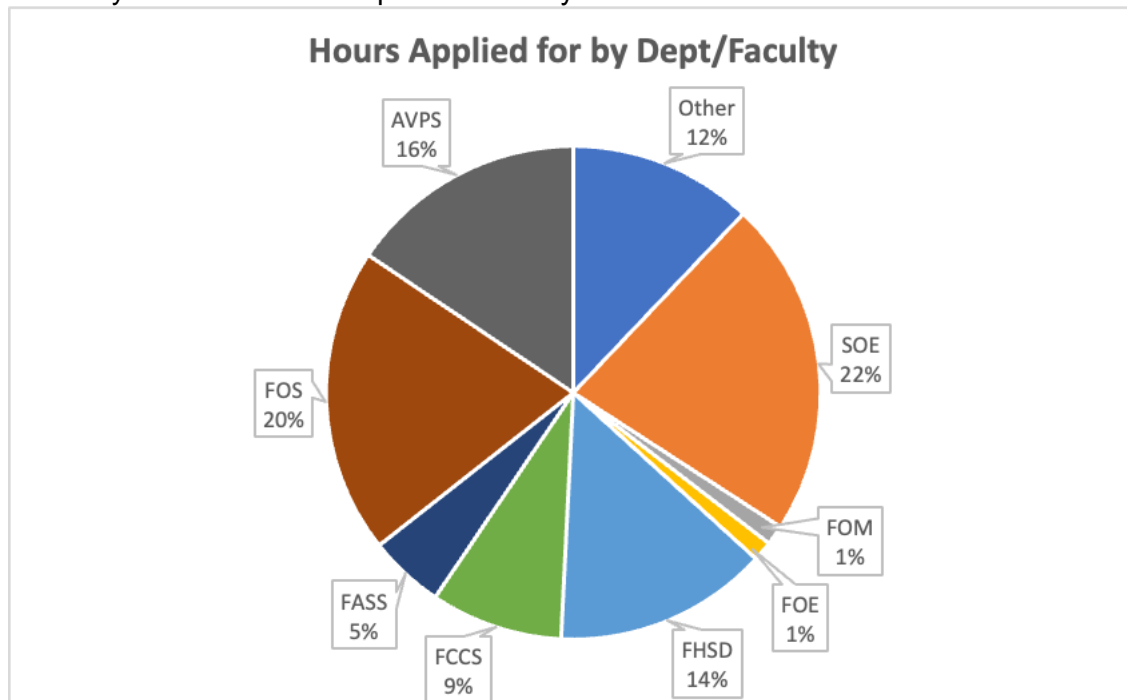
The Work Study budget for 2022 allows us to fund 64% of the number of hours applied for.



## Funding by Faculty/ Department

### Applications

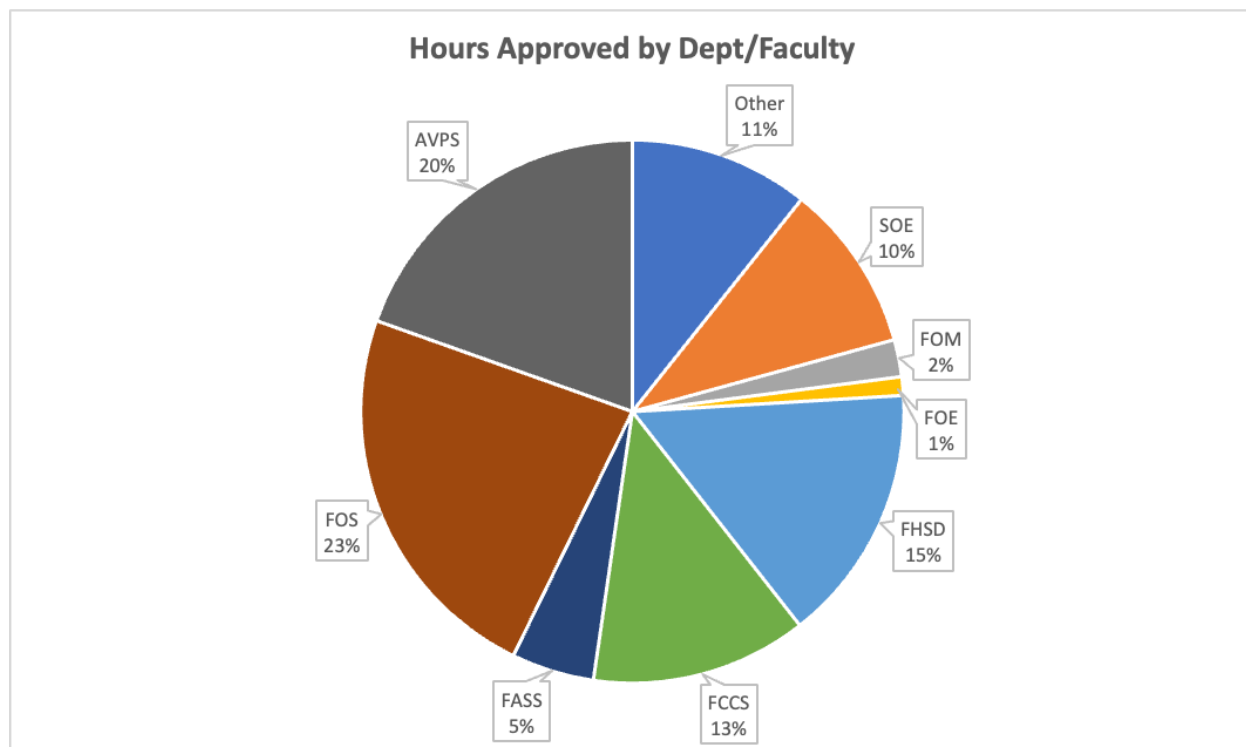
Faculties accounted for 72% of the total of funding requests, while 28% of the total hours were applied for by the rest of the campus community.

## Approvals

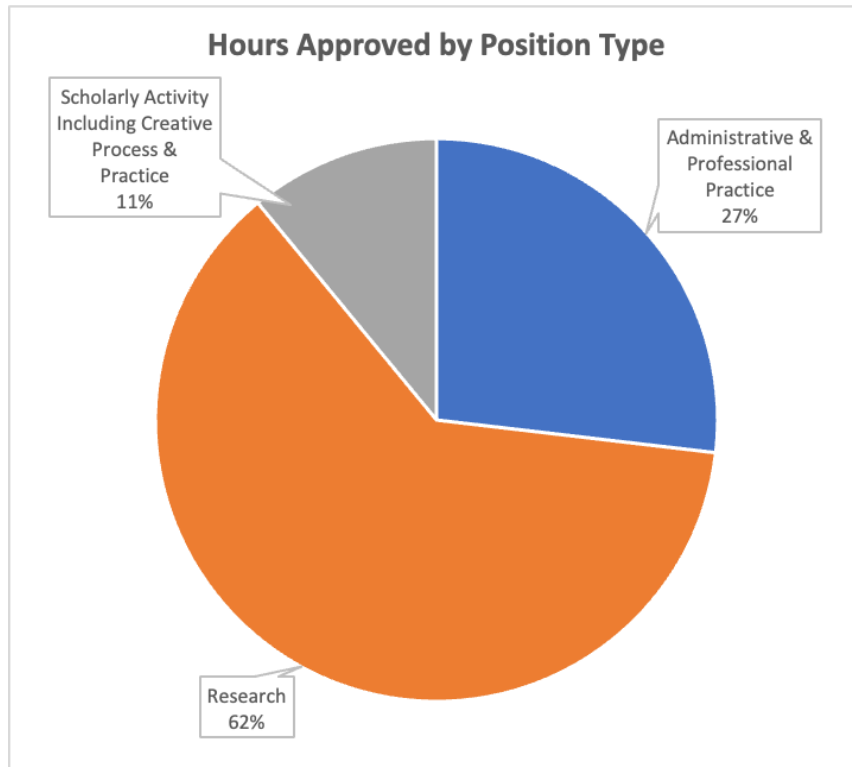
Faculties will account for 71% of the total funding, while 29% will account for the rest of the campus community.

## Types of Work Funded

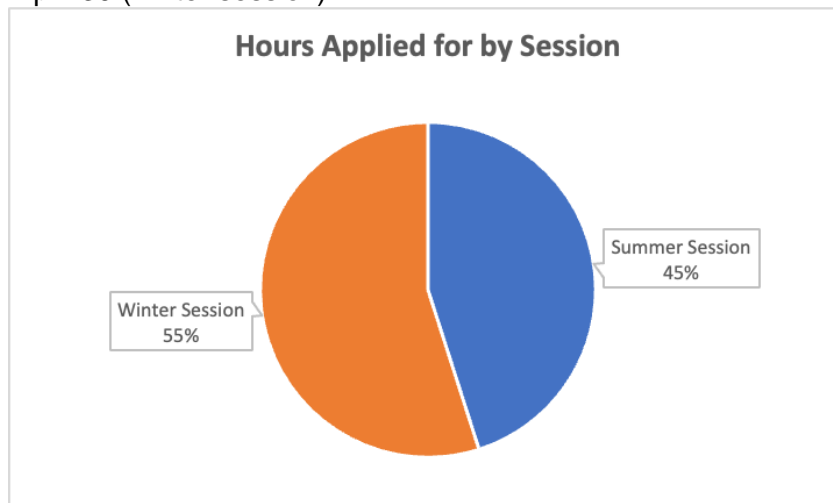
The funding distribution by type of work is outlined below.



## Approvals by Session

### Applications

Of the hours applied for, 45% were for May 1 – August 31 (summer session) while 55% were for September 1 – April 30 (winter session).



## Approvals

Approval distribution matched the applied distribution outlined above. Of the hours approved, 45% were for the period May 1 – August 31 while 55% were for the period September 1 – April 30.
