As the tax filing season approaches, we would like to share the following information, tools, deadlines, and scam awareness resources for you to review.

Leading up to the filing deadline of **April 30**th, **2022**, you may wish to review the Canada Revenue Agency's <u>most recent announcement</u> for students. This announcement covers:

- Filing and payment deadlines
- Tax literacy resources
- Important information about COVID-19 benefits
- CRA digital services (including how to use the "My Account" feature)
- Tax filing assistance (<u>online</u> and <u>in-person</u>)
- Tax credits that are common among students
- Information security
