Review of Assigned Standing

Reviews of assigned standing are governed by the following regulations:

1. Any request for the review of an assigned grade must reach Enrolment Services not later than July 15th for the Winter Session, and not later than October 15th for the Summer Session, and must be accompanied by the necessary fees for each course concerned, which will be refunded only if the mark is raised.
2. Each applicant for a review must state clearly, in a written statement of case, why he or she believes the course deserves a grade higher than that received; pleas on compassionate grounds should not form part of this statement. Prospective applicants should remember that under Senate regulations instructors must re-examine all failing grades and indicate in their records that this has been done.
